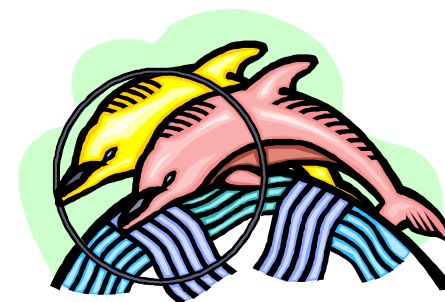

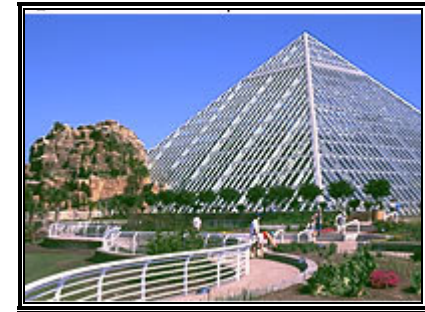

Welcome to Galveston!!



The city of Galveston is on Galveston Island, two miles offshore in the Gulf of Mexico. It is fifty miles from Houston and is the southern terminal point of Interstate Highway 45. It is accessible by a causeway that links the north end of the city to the mainland, a toll bridge on the western end of the island and by ferry boat service to Bolivar Peninsula on the east end of the city. The total population was 57,466 as of the 2005 U. S. Census estimate.

Galveston is known for its historic neighborhoods, and a ten-mile long seawall designed to protect the city from floods. It is also home port for two major cruise lines offering multiple Caribbean cruises.

Some of the numerous city attractions include the Galveston Schlitterbahn waterpark, Moody Gardens, the Lone Star Flight Museum, a downtown neighborhood of historic buildings known as "The Strand," many historical museums and mansions, and miles of beach front.
